- (If you rent the utilities are included in the rent and you pay more than 30% of income toward rent, we can assist with a one-time cash payment.)

The following documentation is required for all in-person appointments and/or proxy, fax, US mail, or county agency "Drop Box"

- Proof of 30-day gross income for ALL household members
- A Copy of your current electric and gas bill
- Photo ID
- Social Security cards for ALL household members
- If you rent, a current rent receipt
- Food Stamp printout, if applicable
